

SUMMIT was held for the 6th time at MIT, Pune. Our meet held 14 disciplines which were Football, Basketball, Volleyball, Cricket, Baseball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Carrom, Squash, Water polo, Swimming & Rowing.

Over 77 colleges participated in SUMMIT with outstation teams coming from major cities like Mumbai, Chennai, Nashik, Kolhapur, Nanded and Ahmednagar. SSN University, Chennai and NIT Kurukshetra were some of the teams outside Maharashtra that participated. More than 3500 sportsperson participated in the five day meet.

Note: Entries will be restricted to only first 20 teams per event, so please send your entries as soon as possible.







Important rules:

- All teams should report 30 minutes before the scheduled time at the respective venues for the fixtures. The team will be forced to forfeit their matches if they reach the respective venue 15 minutes after their scheduled time.
- Misconduct at any point will result in disqualification of the college from the tournament.
- Matches will be delayed if necessitated by circumstances.
- For Inauguration ceremony, sports uniform & flags of respective colleges are necessary.
- Current year I-Cards must be produced at the time of registration and before the match.

Rules and regulations:

Cricket

- 1. Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT.
- 2. Innings will be of 20 overs.
- 3. Maximum no. of players will be 16.
- 4. Whites compulsory.
- 5. If it rains then the decision will be taken on bowl out. Incase of any doubt, please contact the cricket incharge.
- Incase of a tie, winner will be decided on wickets fallen. If further there is a tie then winner will be decided on the basis of a bowl out.

Football

- 1. Maximum of 16 players.
- 2. Colours compulsory, kit compulsory.
- 3. Incase of a draw, penalty shootout will decide the winner

Basketball

- 1. Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate.
- 2. Incase of a tie, 5 minutes of extra time will be allotted.

Volleybal

- 1. Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate.
- 2. Colours compulsory.

Baseball

- Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT.
- 2. Maximum of 16 players.
- 3. Colours compulsory.
- 4. Catcher's kit and batter's helmets are compulsory.

Radmintor

- 1. Minimum players for men: 4, max: 6.
- 2. Minimum players for women: 2, max: 4.
- 3. There will be three singles and two doubles in men's category.
- 4. There will be two singles and one double in women's category.
- 5. There can be a maximum of 3 common players in the men's category where one player can play only one double and one single.

Table Tennis

1. Maximum players for men: 5

- 2. Maximum players for women: 4
- 3. There will be three singles in both the categories, which will be followed by two reverse singles if required.

Lawn Tennis

- 1. Minimum players for men: 2, max: 4.
- 2. Two singles and one doubles match will be played.

Chess

- 1. Maximum of 5 players allowed in the team.
- 2. Chess boards and chess clock is to be brought by players.

Carom

- 1. Maximum 4 players per team.
- 2. There will be two singles and one doubles match.

Squash

- 1. Maximum 5 players allowed in the team.
- 2. Squash balls will be provided.

Water polo

- 1. Maximum no. of players: 13
- 2. Balls will be provided.
- 3. Incase of a draw, 2 halves of 3 mins each will be played & if required then penalty shootout will decide the winner.

Swimming

- 1. Maximum 2 players are allowed for each category from each college.
- 2. Event will be conducted only if no. of participants is at least 4 from 3 different colleges.
- 3. One player can participate in any 3 individual events.
- 4. No spot entries.

Rowing

- 1. Equipment will be provided.
- 2. Event will be conducted only if there are minimum 3 teams from 3 different colleges.
- 3. Colours compulsory.
- 4. Doubling is allowed.

Boxing

- 1. Boxing kit compulsory (Red/Blue Corner)
- 2. IBF approved gloves & head guard compulsory
- 3. Medical checkup compulsory at 8am on the day of event
- 4. Event will be conducted only if there are minimum 3 teams from 3 different colleges.

MIT SUMMIT 2012 General Championship

Winners, runners up & semifinalists will be awarded points accordingly in an event. Based on the maximum points collected during all the events the best college will be chosen and given a prize money of Rs. 25,000/- with a grand trophy.

Winner: 10 pts., Runner up: 6 pts., Semifinalist: 2 pts.

INAGURATION CEREMONY - 10pts.

10 pts will be awarded to every college present for the march-past in the Inaugural Ceremony.

Note: Points will be given to the team events only.







Common rules:

- The registration of all events of your college must be done at one time. Multiple entries from one college will not be accepted.
- ID cards and bonafide certificates should be produced at the time of reporting
- Once the team list is submitted at the time of registration, no changes will be allowed.
- The decision of the umpires will be final and in case of any dispute the captain should contact the game incharge or any member of the organizing team.
- Any changes in the schedule or the timing of the match will be at the discretion of the organizers.
- Right of any changes is given to the organizing committee.
- In case of a protest submit **Rs. 1,000/- as protest fees** and protest application, within one hour of finish of the match.
- Only students pursuing a Bachelor of Engineering (B.E) or a Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech) will be allowed to participate.

For colleges outside pune:

- Please send the registration forms, players list as well as the undertaking signed by the sports in charge/secretary back to MIT.

- 4. The participating teams should send a fax of registration form in order to confirm registration.

For colleges in Pune itself:

- The registration of all events of your college must be done at one time. Multiple entries from one college will not be accepted.
- 2. Registration fees should be paid at the MIT gymkhana registration desk.
- 3. Without the payment of the registration fee your entry will not be considered.
- Please bring the receipt of the fees paid at the time of reporting.

5. Signing of the undertaking by the sports in charge /secretary is a must without which none of your college teams will be allowed to participate.

At the time of registration:

- You will have to send a separate DD of Rs. 5000 /- as a deposit in favor of "Maharashtra Institute of Technology, Pune" as aconfirmation of your accommodation. This amount will be returned to you when you are leaving Pune.
- 2. In case of misbehavior of any kind MIT, Pune reserves the right to take any punitive action, even to the extent of confiscating the security deposit and registration fees, cancelling the participation of the concerned college, escorting them off the campus and sending a report of the misconduct to the head of the concerned institution.
- 3. Extra accommodation and boarding facilities will be charged as applicable.

Accommodation details

All the teams participating in SUMMIT '12 coming from outside Pune city will be given accommodation by MIT under the following conditions.

On your arrival in Pune.

- 1. Report at the MIT, Kothrud Campus help desk where you will be informed about your accommodation details.
- 2. Incase the D.D. has not been given due to any circumstance, you can deposit Rs. 5,000/- in cash, at the help desk, as the security deposit which will be refunded while leaving Pune.
- 3. MIT will provide you with mattresses and quilts. You need not bring it along.
- 4. If you have not registered beforehand then MIT will be helpless in finding you accommodation.
- 5. Per head expenditure of accommodation, food & transport will be Rs. 1,500/- for five days i.e. 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th and 20thSeptember, 2012.
- 6. The teams coming on 15th September should report at MIT Gymkhana before 2 p.m and should be present on the ground at 3:30 p.m. for the Inaugural Ceremony.
- 7. The lodging will be provided on 15th September free of cost (excluding boarding facility).
- 8. Apart from this you can make arrangements for your own accommodation as per your convenience.
