

- Last date of entry for Cricket: 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2017.
- Last date of entry for the remaining events is 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.

**Note:** Entries will be restricted to only first 20 teams per event, so please send your entries as soon as possible.



- All teams should report 30 minutes before the scheduled time at the respective venues for the fixtures. The team will be forced to forfeit their matches if they reach the respective venue 15 minutes after their scheduled match.
- Misconduct on and off the field at any point during the event will result in disqualification from the tournament.
- Matches will be delayed if necessary due to unforeseen circumstances.
- For the Inauguration Ceremony, sports uniform & flags of respective colleges are necessary and it is compulsory for all the participants to participate in the March Past.
- Current year I-Cards, Original Fee Receipt and Bonafide Certificates with player's photo and college seal (half on photo, half on certificate) must be produced at the time of registration as well as before each match.
- Every participant must present previous year's marksheet when demanded by the respective event head
- Any participant with backlog in any final year paper will not be allowed to participate.





# **Rules & Regulations**



### Cricket

- Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT
- Innings will be of 20 overs
- Maximum no. of players will be 16
- Whites are compulsory
- If it rains then the decision will be taken on 'bowl out'
- In case of a tie, the winner will be decided on wickets fallen. If further there is a tie, then the winner will be decided on the basis of a bowl out.
- In case any team loses in First Round due to 'bowl out' then 50% of their registration fees will be refunded to the respective team



### Kabaddi

- Maximum of 12 players in a team are allowed
- Two halves of 15 minutes will be allotted
- Colours are compulsory
- Matches will be played according to Kabaddi Federation of India rules and regulations
- Players upto 80 kg weight are allowed to participate



### **Badminton**

- Minimum players for men: 4, max: 6.
- Minimum players for women: 2, max: 4.
- There will be three singles and two doubles in men's category.
- There will be two singles and one double in women's category.
- There can be a maximum of 3 common players in the men's category where one player can play only one double & one single.



### **Football**

- Maximum of 18 players
- Colours and kit are compulsory
- Incase of a draw, penalty shootout will decide the winne



### **Basketball**

- Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate
- Incase of a tie, 5 minutes of extra time will be allotted
- · Colours and kit are compulsory



### Volleyball

- Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate
- · Colours and kit are compulsory



### **Baseball**

- Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT
- Maximum of 16 players are allowed to participate
- Colours are compulsory
- Catcher's kit and batter's helmets are compulsory



### **Table Tennis**

- Maximum players for men: 5
- Maximum players for women: 4
- There will be three singles in both the categories, which will be followed by two reverse singles if required



### Chess

- Maximum of 6 players allowed
- Chess boards & chess clock is to be brought by players



### Carrom

- Maximum 4 players per team
- There will be two singles & one doubles match



### **Swimming**

- Maximum 2 players are allowed for each category from each college
- Event will be conducted only if no. of participants is atleast 4 from 3 different colleges
- One player can participate in any 3 individual events



### Squash

- Maximum 5 players are allowed to participate
- Squash balls will be provided



### Rowing

- Equipment will be provided.
- Event will be conducted only if there are minimum 3 teams from 3 different colleges
- Colours are compulsory
- · Doubling is allowed

Inauguration Ceremony: 10 pts.

10 pts will be awarded to every college present for the march-past in the Inaugural Ceremony.

**Note:** Points will be given for team events only.





- The registration of all events of your college must be done at one time. Multiple entries from one college will not be accepted
- Once the team list is submitted at the time of registration, no changes will be allowed
- The decision of the umpires will be final and in case of any dispute the captain should contact the event in-charge or organizers
- Any changes in the schedule or the timing of the match will be at the discretion of the organizers
- First Aid Kit and Ambulance will be provided by us. Our College and Event will not be responsible for any injuries or mishaps during the event
- Right of any changes is given to the organizing committee
- In case of a protest submit Rs. 3,000/- as protest fees and protest application before or within one hour after the match
- Only students pursuing a Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) or a Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) will be allowed to participate

- 2) Please send the registration form, players list, Bonafide certificate as well as the undertaking signed by the sports in-charge/secretary back to MIT. A team will need to send the scanned copy of the above documents by mail within a period of 5 days or the registration will be cancelled.

#### **Accommodation Details**

All the teams participating in SUMMIT '17 coming from outside Pune city will be given accommodation by MIT under the following conditions:

#### At the time of registration:

- 1) Accommodation fees to be paid online along with the registration form for colleges seeking accommodation.
- 2) You will also need to pay a fee of Rs. 5000 as a deposit which will be returned after the event. This deposit has to be paid at the time of registration itself. Accommodation will not be entertained later on.
- 3) In case of misbehavior of any kind, MIT reserves the right to take any punitive action, even to the extent of confiscating the security deposit and registration fees, cancelling the participation of the concerned college, escorting them off the campus and sending a report of the misconduct to the head of the concerned institution.
- 4) Extra accommodation and boarding facilities will be charged as applicable.

#### On your arrival in Pune:

- 1) Report at the MIT, Kothrud Campus help desk where you will be informed about your accommodation details.
- 2) MIT will provide you with mattresses and quilts.
- 3) If you have not registered beforehand then MIT will not be responsible for your accommodation.
- 4) Per head expenditure of accommodation, food (breakfast, lunch and dinner) & transport will be Rs. 1,500/- for five days i.e. 14th, 15th, 16, 17, 18th of September. The teams coming on 14th September should report at MIT Gymkhana before 2 p.m. and should be present on the ground at 3:30 p.m. for the march past at the Inaugural Ceremony.
- 5) Apart from this you can make arrangements of your own as per your convenience.
