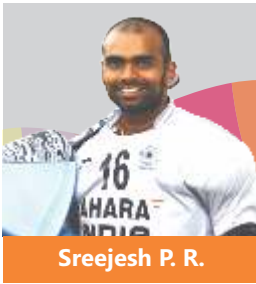

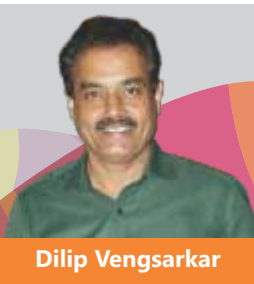

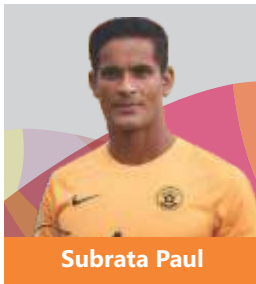

Journey So Far

In the earlier times, it was a challenge for engineering students to participate in sports events at University, State and National levels due to various reasons like long distances, cost of travel and absence of various opportunities and platforms in general. In order to give these students a fair chance to present their sports abilities, MIT-WPU, Pune decided to organize an annual sports fest dedicated for engineering students, which would club various sports competitions over a span of 5 days.

Thus, MIT Summit was first held in our college from 10th to 12th Sept '04, with 9 events and over 1,700 students participating from different colleges within Pune District. In 2007, on the prestigious day of Gandhi Jayanti, MIT institutes celebrated their Silver Jubilee and MIT Summit was declared a State Level Sports Meet. By 2009, MIT Summit grew to become a National Level Sports Meet, with participation increasing to 3,500 students from over 85 colleges.

Important Rules

- All teams should report **30 minutes** before the scheduled time at the respective venues for the fixtures. The team will be forced to forfeit their matches if they reach the respective venue **15 minutes** after their scheduled match.
- Misconduct on and off the field at any point during the event will result in disqualification from the tournament.
- Matches will be delayed if necessary due to unforeseen circumstances.
- For the Inauguration Ceremony, sports uniform & flags of respective colleges are necessary and it is compulsory for all the participants to participate in the March Past.
- Every participant must present **previous year's mark sheet** when demanded by the respective event head.
- Any participant with **backlog** in any **final year** paper will not be allowed to participate.
- Minimum four teams from four different colleges are required for the conduction of an event.
- All matches will be played by the Federation rules of respected games.

Rules & Regulations



Cricket

- Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT.
- Innings will be of 20 overs.
- Maximum no. of players will be 16.
- Whites are compulsory.
- If it rains then the decision will be taken on **'bowl out'**.
- In case of a tie, the winner will be decided on wickets fallen. If further there is a tie, then the winner will be decided based on a bowl out.
- In case any team loses in First Round due to 'bowl out' then 50% of their registration, fees will be refunded to the respective team.



Football

- Maximum of 18 players.
- Colours and kit are compulsory.
- In case of a draw, penalty shootout will decide the winner.



Basketball

- Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate.
- In case of a tie, 5 minutes of extra time will be allotted.
- Colors and kit are compulsory.



Volleyball

- Maximum of 12 players are allowed to participate.
- Colours and kit are compulsory.
- In case of three sides, third set will be of 15 points.



Baseball

- Each team will have to pay for balls, which will be provided by MIT.
- Maximum of 16 players are allowed to participate.
- Colours are compulsory.
- Catcher's kit and batter's helmets are compulsory.



Kabaddi

- Maximum of 12 players in a team are allowed.
- Two halves of 15 minutes will be allotted.
- Colours are compulsory.
- Matches will be played according to Kabaddi Federation of India rules and regulations.
- Players up to 80 kg weight are allowed to participate.



Badminton

- Minimum players for men: 4, max: 6.
- Minimum players for women: 2, max: 4.
- There will be three singles and two doubles in men's category.
- There will be two singles and one double in women's category.
- There can be a maximum of three common players in the men's category where one player can play only one double and one single.





Table Tennis

- Maximum players for men: 5
- Maximum players for women: 4
- There will be three singles in both the categories, which will be followed by two reverse singles if required.



Chess

- Maximum of six players allowed.
- Chess boards and chess clock is to be brought by players.



Squash

- Maximum five players are allowed to participate.
- Squash balls will be provided.



Swimming

- Maximum two players are allowed for each category from each college.
- Event will be conducted only if no. of participants is atleast 4 from 3 different colleges.
- One player can participate in any three individual events.



Lawn Tennis

- Minimum players for men: 2, max: 4.
- Minimum players for women: 2, max: 4.
- Two singles and one doubles match will be played.



Carrom

- Maximum five players per team.
- There will be two singles and one doubles match.



Water Polo

- Maximum of 13 players are allowed to participate.
- Incase of a draw, two halves of 3 minutes each will be played & if required then penalty shootout will decide the winner.



Rowing

- Equipment will be provided.
- Event will be conducted only if there are minimum three teams from three different colleges.
- Colours are compulsory.
- Doubling is allowed.

All the teams participating in SUMMIT '18 coming from outside Pune city will be given accommodation by MIT under the following conditions

- **At the time of registration:**
- Accommodation fees to be paid online along with the registration form for colleges seeking accommodation.
- You will also need to pay a fee of Rs. 5000 as a deposit, which will be returned after the event. This deposit has to be paid at the time of registration itself. Accommodation will not be entertained later on.
- In case of misbehavior of any kind, MIT reserves the right to take any punitive action, even to the extent of confiscating the security deposit and registration fees, cancelling the participation of the concerned college, escorting them off the campus and sending a report of the misconduct to the head of the concerned institution.
- Extra accommodation and boarding facilities will be charged as applicable.
- **On your arrival in Pune:**
- Report at the MIT, Kothrud Campus help desk where you will be informed about your accommodation details.
- MIT will provide you with mattresses and quilts.
- If you have not registered beforehand then MIT will not be responsible for your accommodation.
